Paraguard Intrauterine Device Financial Policy

We require that you pay a down-payment of \$400 prior to our office ordering your ParaGuard from the manufacturer, regardless of insurance coverage. You will also be required to sign a waiver that you agree to pay for any remaining balance that is not covered by insurance. Once your ParaGuard IUD is ordered, it usually takes 2-3 business days for it to be delivered to our office. The appointment for insertion must be within 5 days of starting your period (day 1 is the first day you bleed).

Private Pay patients

At your appointment, you will owe the insertion fee (\$175) and the remaining balance of the device (\$200).

Insured patients

At your appointment, you will owe your co-pay for the insertion procedure. After the insertion, we will file a claim with your insurance company. If the ParaGuard IUD device and insertion are covered benefits and there is a credit on your account, we will refund you accordingly once your insurance has paid on the claim. The refund may or may not be the exact amount of your initial upfront payment depending on the amount your insurance pays and any other debts outstanding on your account. If this is not a covered benefit, you will be responsible for the remaining balance.
